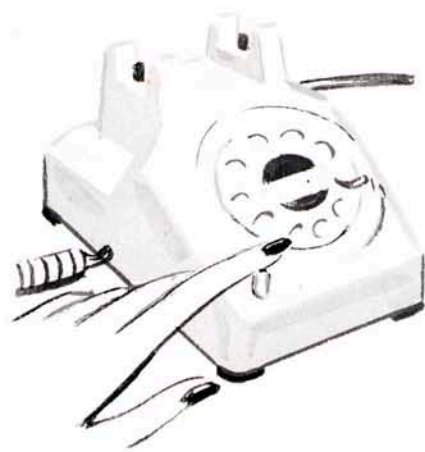

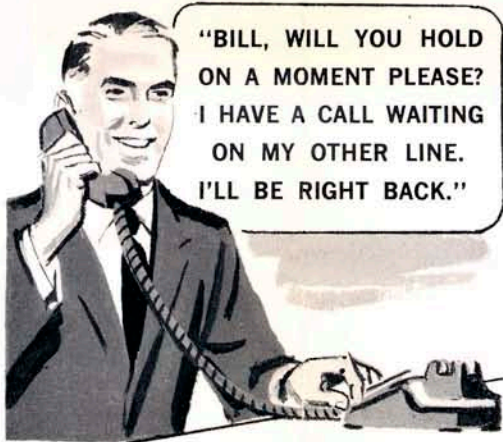


Mr. Smith's secretary put this call on "hold" while she rang for him on the second line. Mr. Smith then took the call on the nearest phone.

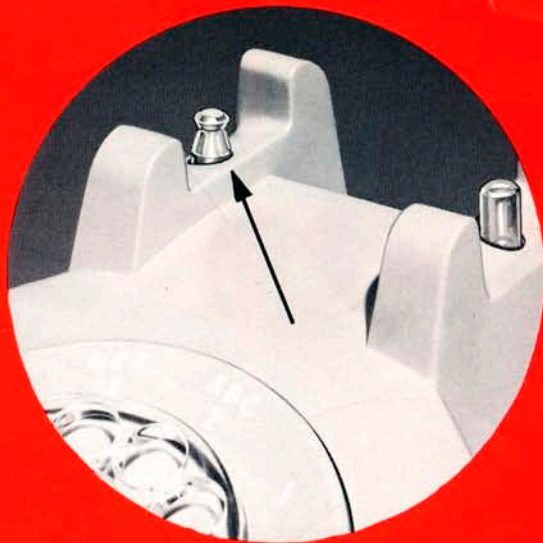

HOLD BUTTON

To hold a call, lift this button and turn the line selection key to the other line. This action simultaneously holds one line and opens the other. Both lines can be held at the same time.



LINE SELECTION KEY

Turn the key to the left for one line or to a vertical position for the second line. The key may be depressed for signalling.
