The half pages appear together as the last page of the PDF.

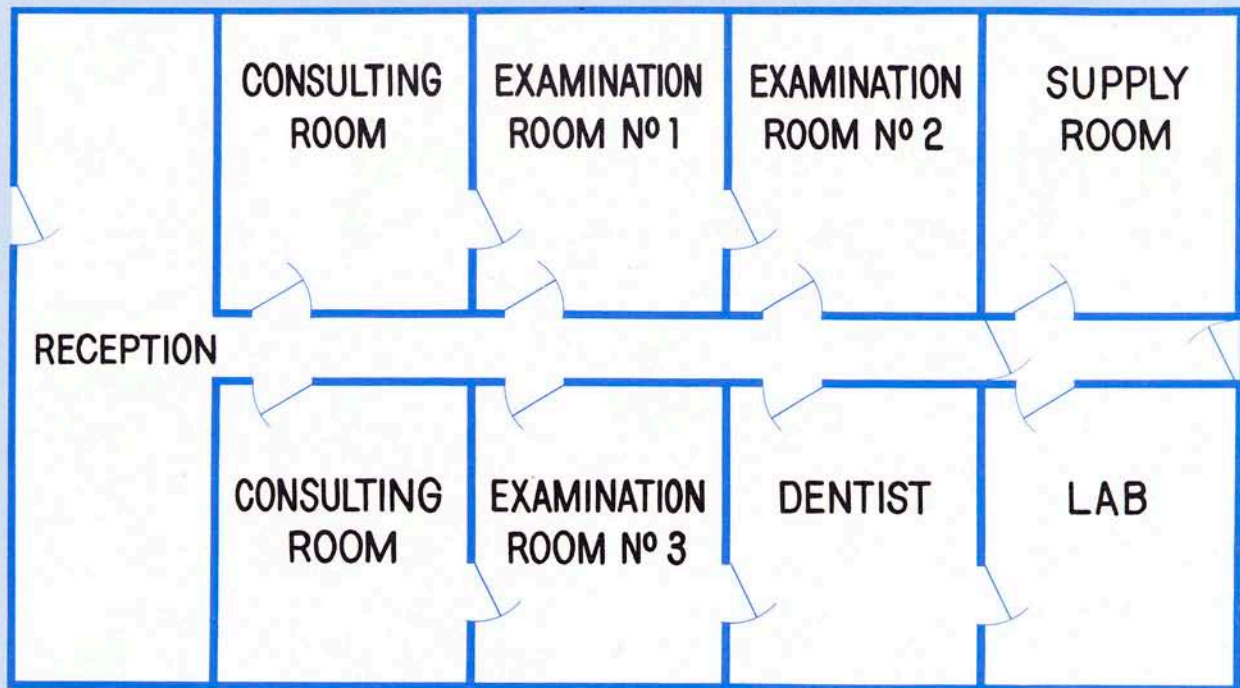

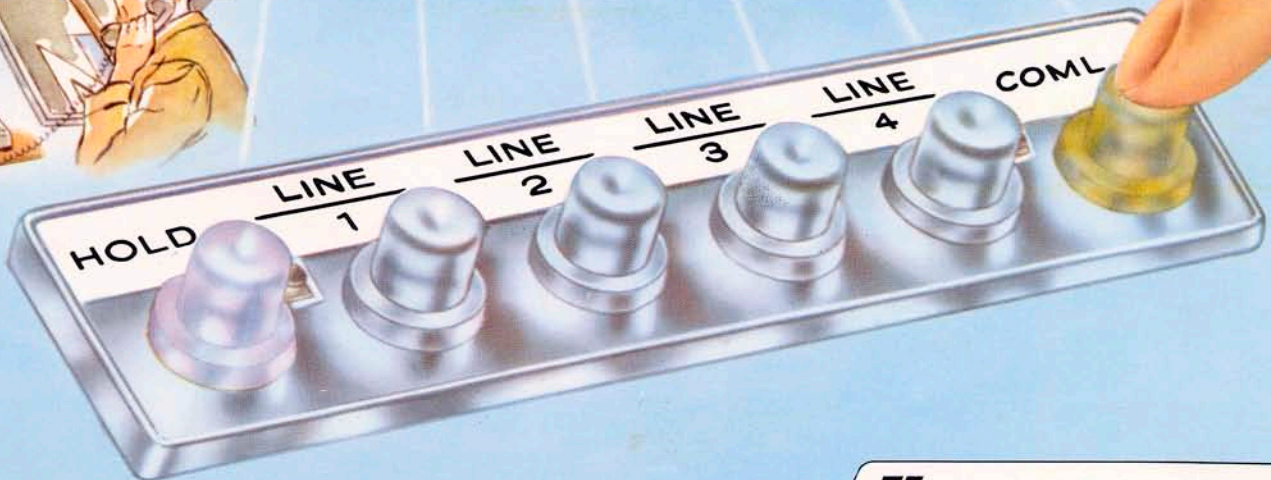

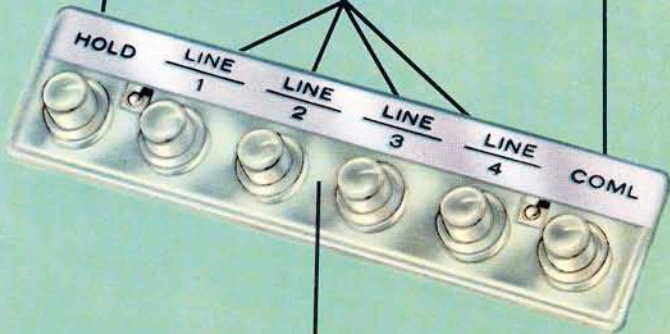


# K-1A1 FEATURES

**HOLD**  
Just press hold button to "hold" one call, then press line pick-up button to answer or place another call. A visual flashing signal may be provided for each line pick-up button as a reminder that a line is being "held."

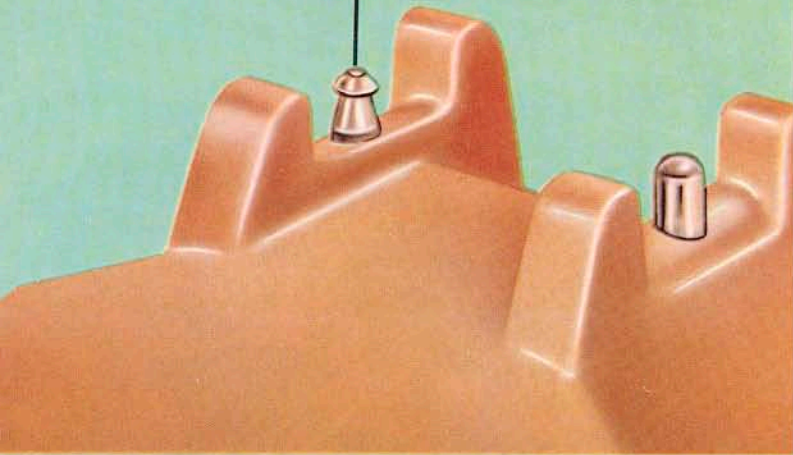
**LINE PICK-UP BUTTONS**  
Central Office or private branch exchange line pick-up buttons illuminated for visual indication flash signals for incoming calls — steady light on lines in use — Lights show on all telephones simultaneously.

**INTERCOM**  
Dial or manual intercom line. No need of purchasing a separate phone system for inter-office calls.



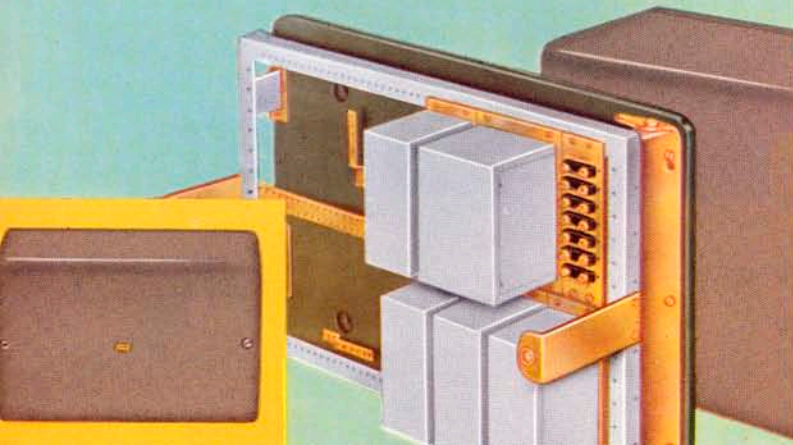
## EXECUTIVE EXCLUSION FEATURE

The K-1A1 may be equipped to cut other telephones off the line by lifting the plunger, permitting confidential calls. The line is automatically restored when the handset is replaced.



## APPARATUS CABINET

The operating equipment is housed in one compact cabinet which permits its installation at almost any desired wall location. This also allows expansion when needed without moving or rearranging the apparatus.
